Wrap bare or green ground wire around green ground screw on the crossbar, no less than 2 inches from the end of the wire. Tighten the areen around screw. B. Use standard wire connectors (not included) to make all wire connections. Twist connectors until wires are tightly joined together. Wrap each connection with approved electrical tape and carefully Optional stuff all the connected wires into the Outlet Box. Pass the supply wires from outlet box through the Crossbar Assembly (A). Attach the Crossbar Assembly (A) to the Outlet Box with the head of the Green Ground Screw facing you. Secure the Bare, or Green Ground wire Crossbar Assembly (A) with Outlet Box Screws (not included). Ground wire from Fixture Tighten until snug. from outlet box Green Ground Screw Figure 3 Outlet Box on the Crossbar Figure 1 Outlet Box Screws STEP 4 - Install the Fixture Supply Wires with (not included) Ground Wire A. Carefully tuck all wires into the outlet box and position the Fixture Canopy over the outlet box. Align the holes in the ceiling canopy with the mounting screws, then attach the Fixture Canopy using the STEP 2 - Test Fitting Ceiling Canopy to Crossbar Assembly previously removed mounting balls. Hand tighten until snug. A. Remove mounting balls from the Crossbar Assembly (A). Fit the Fixture Canopy to the Crossbar Assembly (A) and secure with mounting balls. Note: The Fixture Canopy should be snug against the ceiling and the mounting balls. If not, adjust the length of the nipple on the Crossbar Assembly (A) by unscrewing the preassembled hex nut and lock washer and then screwing the Hex Nut and mounting screws in or out of the crossbar until the correct length is Mounting Screw Lock Washer achieved. Once the Fixture Canopy is secure, remove the mounting Fixture Canopy ball and Fixture Canopy and proceed to Step 3.
